

Scoping Comments

The Circ-Williston Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is a new look at transportation improvements in the area between I-89 and Williston, Essex, and Essex Junction. Scoping is the first phase of the EIS, in which the public, local officials, concerned organizations, and state and federal agencies provide input on the problems to be solved, the potential improvements, and the issues to be studied.

VTrans and Federal Highway Administration invite your input to scoping. **Comments must be received by April 7** to become part of the Scoping Memorandum, which serves as the work plan for the EIS. After Scoping is completed, there will be other opportunities for the public to provide comments and input during other phases of the EIS process.
